1. OBJECTIVES OF THE ROLE

This volunteer role supports the mission of UNCC to enhance the health, education, safety, and livelihoods of aged persons, persons with disabilities, asylum seekers, and child-mothers. The volunteer will assist in delivering services that protect human rights and promote community resilience, with a focus on marginalized groups.

2. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support aged seniors and child-mothers through community outreach and health education.
- Assist in delivering services at emergency shelters for child-mothers, ensuring safety, hygiene, and basic needs.
- Participate in livelihoods initiatives that promote economic empowerment for seniors and asylum seekers.
- Help coordinate educational activities for children and young mothers.
- Monitor and report on child abuse cases and work with police desks for further follow-up and legal action.
- Conduct risk assessments and support referral pathways across UNCC programs.
- Collaborate with multidisciplinary teams including legal, medical, food security, and education departments.
- Maintain confidentiality and proper documentation of client interactions and case management.

3. EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- Improved quality of life and dignity for aged individuals, refugees, and child-mothers.
- Stronger protective systems for victims of abuse and violence.
- Increased access to health and education for vulnerable community members.
- Integrated support services that address social, legal, and economic needs.
